
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


1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?




2. How well did the teacher prepare for the classes?




3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?




4. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and application.





c) On the basis of the data analysed above, the following Action is Prescribed:

1. Teacher Council Secretary and Academic Sub-Committee are to take immediate steps to enhancethe average syllabus coverage and usage of ICT among the teachers. It was found that the feedback received from the students in this regard were not entirely satisfactory.

2. The Student's Welfare Committee, Bursar, Head Clerk and the Purchase committee is requested tolook into the affairs of a) canteen to identify and eliminate the causes of dissatisfaction and b) laboratory(s) to develop the facilities available.

3. It has been reflected in the feedback received that a section of the students is still not aware ofinternal Complaints Committee/Grievance Redressal Committee or the Anti Ragging cell. The convenors of the abovementioned committees are requested to carry out awareness activities among the students.
