Report

Department of Political Science of Polba Mahavidyalaya organized a One Day Educational Visit at Polba Dadpur Block on 30th December. 2024, at 12:00pm onward. There was total nine participants. The visit aimed to provide practical exposure to grassroots governance, rural development, and the functioning of local self-governance institutions. The tour's primary objective was to supplement classroom learning by offering hands-on experience regarding the functioning of Panchayati Raj Institutions (PRIs), rural administration, and development initiatives in a semi-urban setting. Students interacted with members of the Gram Panchayat, Block Development Officers (BDOs), and other local representatives. The discussions revolved around governance policies, implementation of welfare schemes, and challenges faced in rural administration. The students visited various development sites, including schools, healthcare centers, irrigation projects, and community centres, to understand how government schemes like MNREGA and PMAY are executed.
