a. The following responses are discussed as received in the 73 offline feedbacks.

The parents participated in this feedback seeking session with great enthusiasm. They have held a general satisfaction with the affairs of the institution with a few suggestions especially in case of infrastructural growth and a job oriented approach in the transactions in the college. A platform has also been sought for parent-college interaction.

In the light of this, the following course of action has been suggested by the IQAC:

- 1. Development of physical infrastructure like classroom and lab must be undertaken. The IQAC has resolved to send appeals for grant in aid from the Department of Higher Education, Govt. of West Bengal to ensure the achievement of this endeavor.
- 2. A regular interaction is to be maintained with parents by the departments, till an online / offline platform for interaction is not created.
- 3. Career counseling and placement cell to organize more employable skill generating sessions. Add on courses to be organized keeping this end in aim.


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


Q.1. Do you believe that the college and its environment has transformed the personality of your ward? yes 73 no 0
