Report Analysis of Feedback given by Students and Action Taken Period – 2019-2020

Type of Feedback: Students

Overall :2019-2020

The following are the issues discussed regarding the feedback received from 400 students in online mode through the circulation of a google form. The mode was taken in view of the ongoing pandemic. The discussion takes place in the course of an online meeting of the IQAC held on 21.07.2020.

- a. The IQAC expresses satisfaction at the survey conducted among the students. Questions ranged across a Spectrum of parameters from curriculum to teaching quality to internal assessment to online classes. The Survey had questions to ascertain the quality of infrastructure, library and sports facilities. In order to ascertain the role of the management, the survey had questions on the accessibility of the management, the survey had questions on the accessibility of the HOI as well.

On the basis of the findings, the proposal of action stands as follows:

1. Taking note that 5% of students are not happy with the washroom facilities, the IQAC is concerned about the feedback. The Principal, IQAC and Governing Body is requested to upgrade the washroom facilities and augment the physical facilities as well with immediate effect.
2. Classroom facilities should be improved.
3. Teachers' Council and Academic Committee to push towards absolute satisfaction regarding teaching-learning in near future, although the result is generally positive.

METHOD- The student feedback was conducted online through a google form. The form was shared in the college website. 400 of our current students responded to the survey. The survey was conducted on grounds of anonymity to give the opportunity to the opportunity to the students for a free and fair review.

b. RECCOMENDATIONS

- 1.Improving infrastructure (e.g., upgrading classrooms or library resources)
- 2.Enhancing academic support (e.g., tutoring or mentorship programs)
- 3.Expanding extracurricular activities or student organizations
- 4.Fostering a more inclusive campus culture
- 5.Improving communication channels between students and faculty/administration

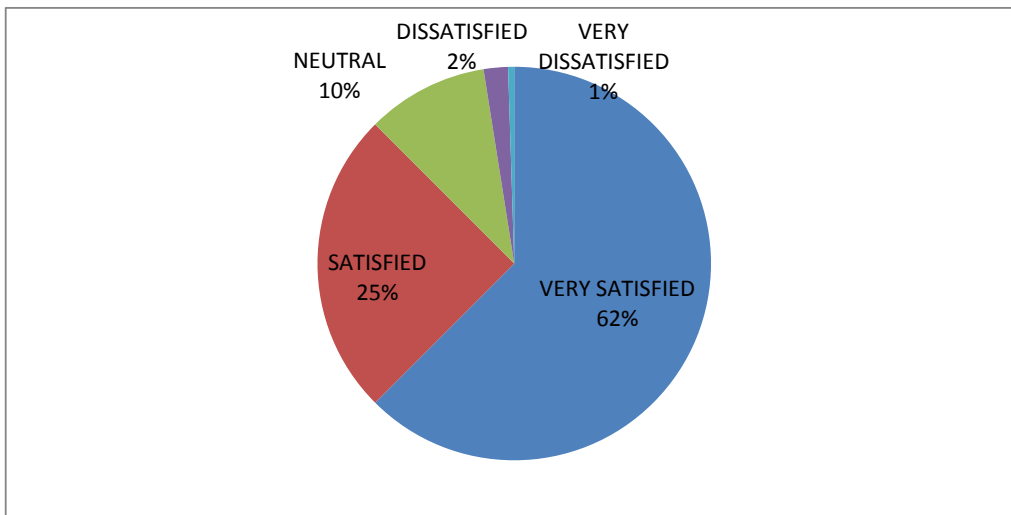

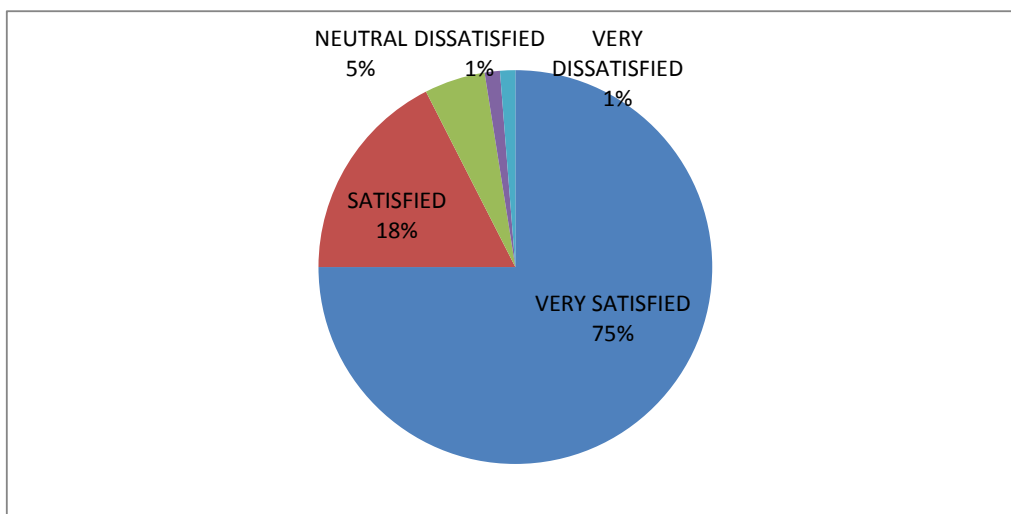
Q.1 How satisfied are you with the overall quality of education provided by the college?

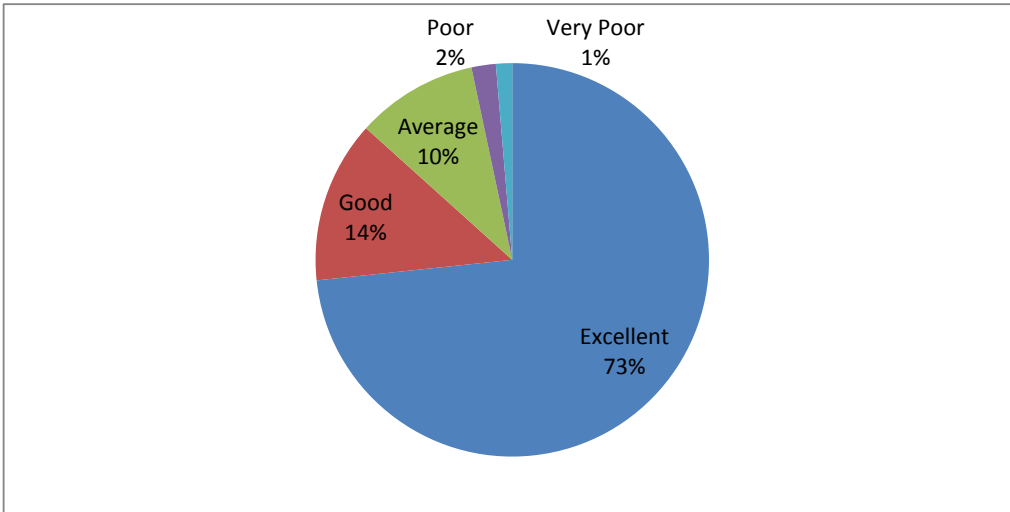
Q.2 How would you rate the availability of academic resources and support services at the college (e.g., library, tutoring, advising)?*

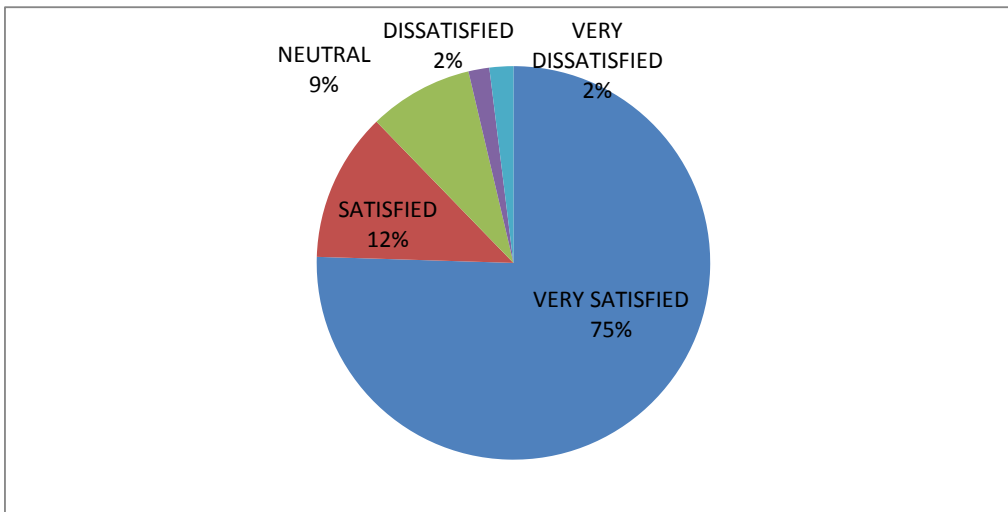
Q.3 Rate the effectiveness of career services provided by the college (e.g., job/internship assistance, resume workshops).*

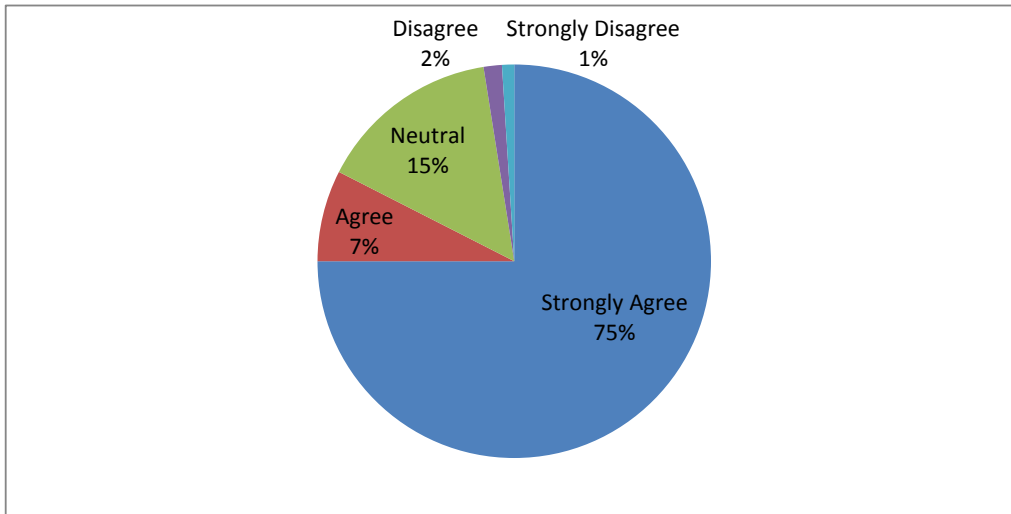
Q.4 How satisfied are you with the campus facilities and infrastructure (e.g., classrooms, labs, recreational areas)?

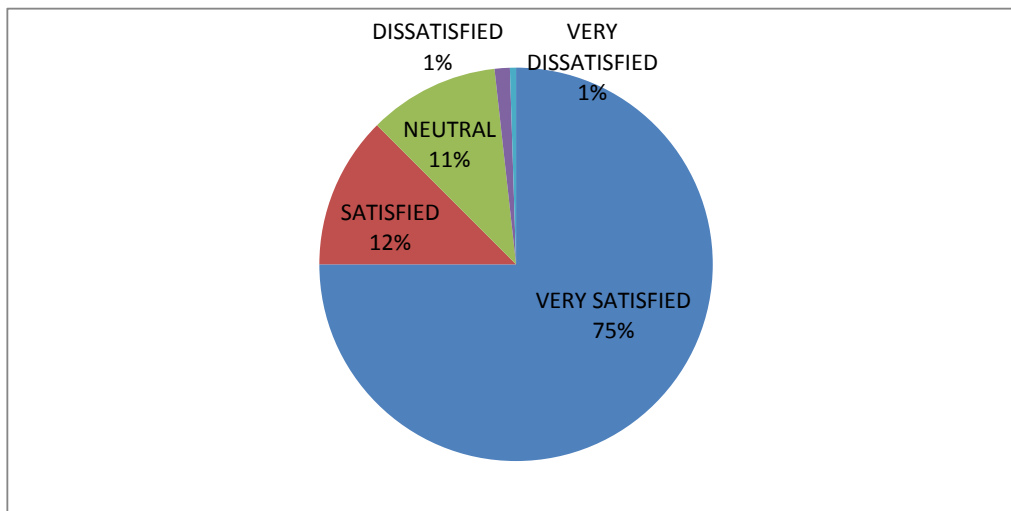
Q.5 Do you feel that the college fosters a supportive and inclusive community for students from diverse backgrounds?

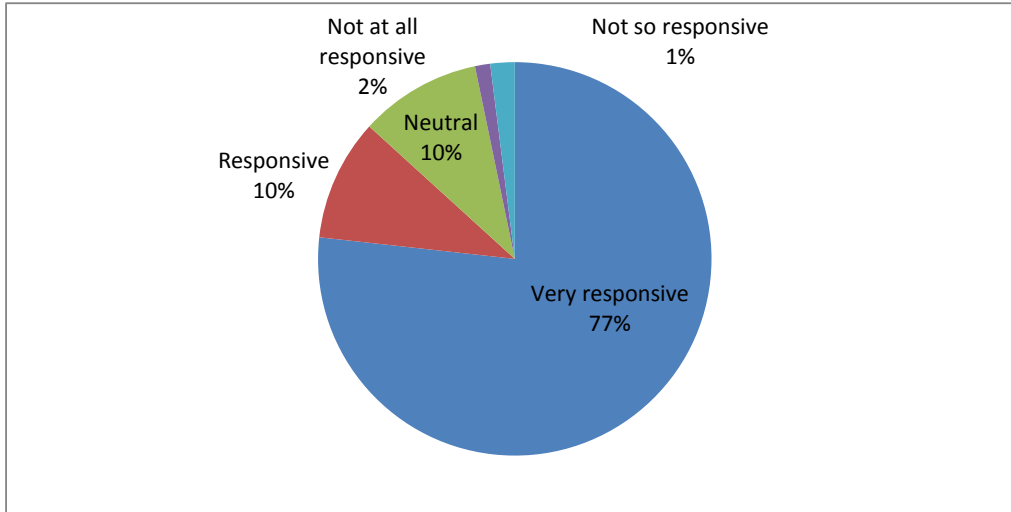
Q.6 Rate your overall satisfaction with the extracurricular activities and opportunities offered by the college (e.g., sports, events).

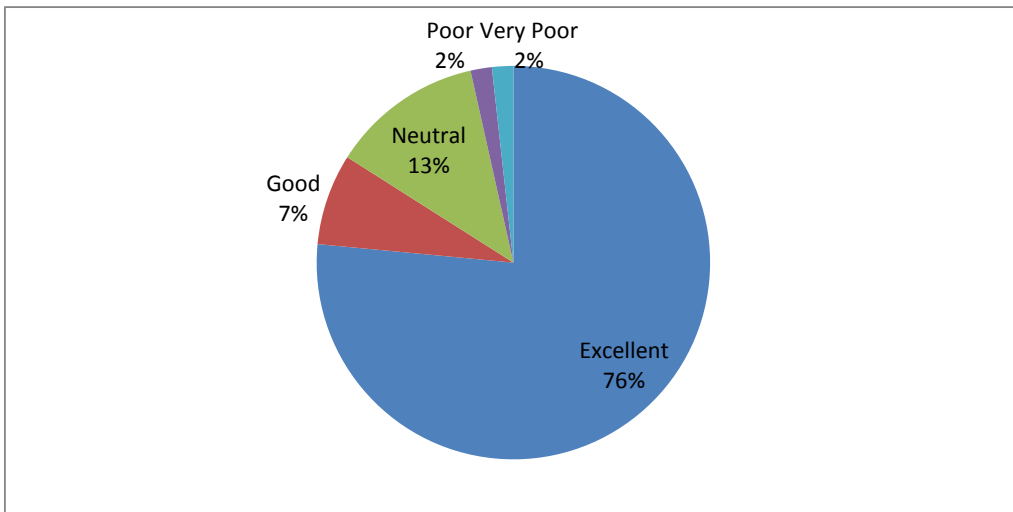
Q.7 How responsive are faculty and staff to students' concerns and feedback?

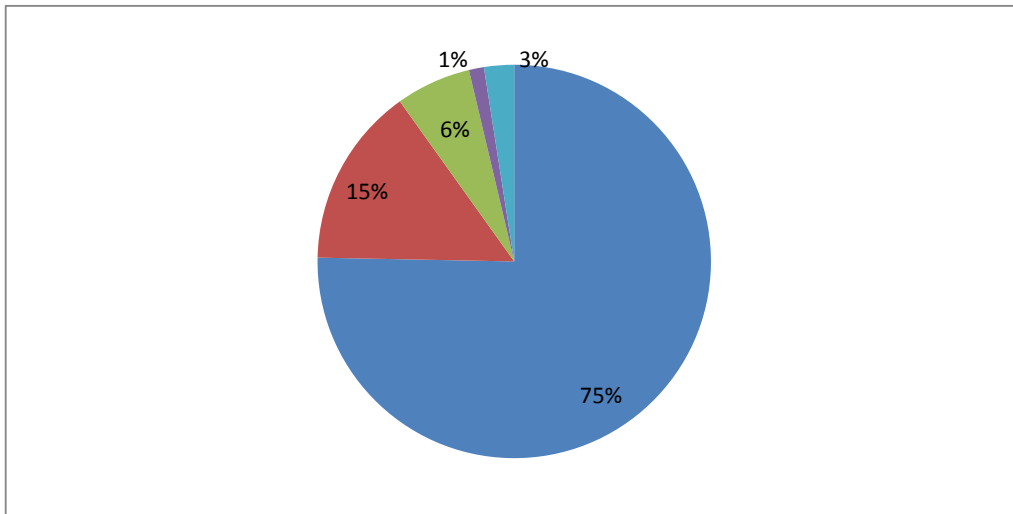

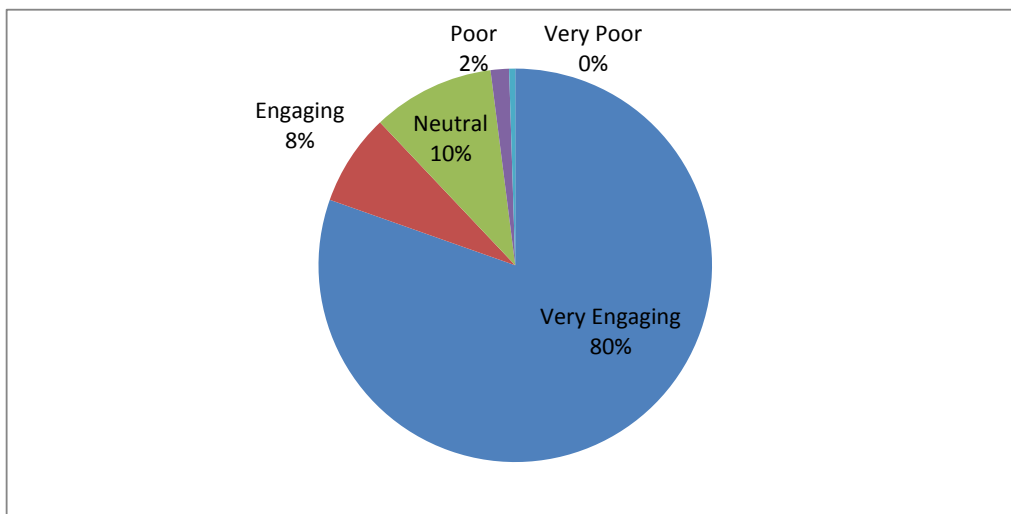
Q.9 Rate the effectiveness of the course in covering important topics and concepts.

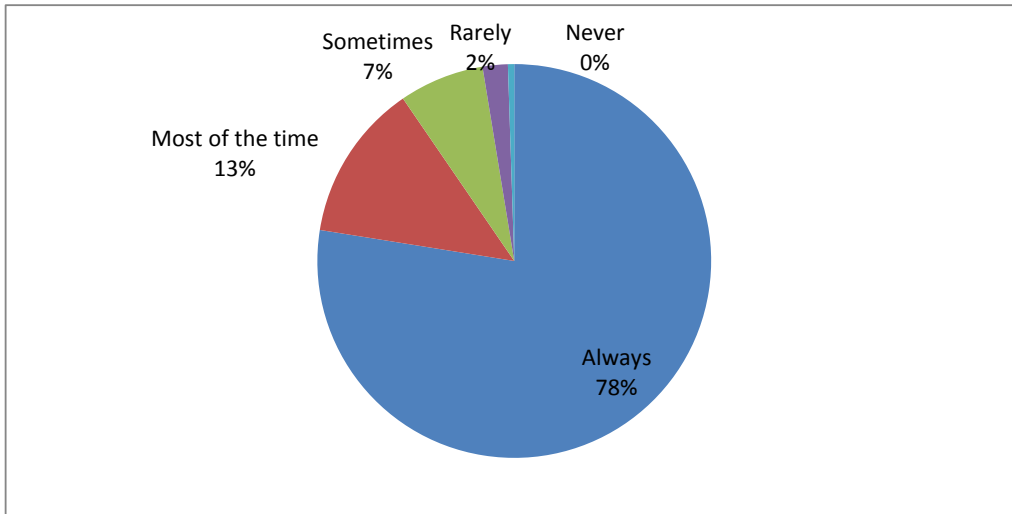
Q.10 How engaging were the teaching methods used in the course (e.g., lectures, discussions, group projects)?

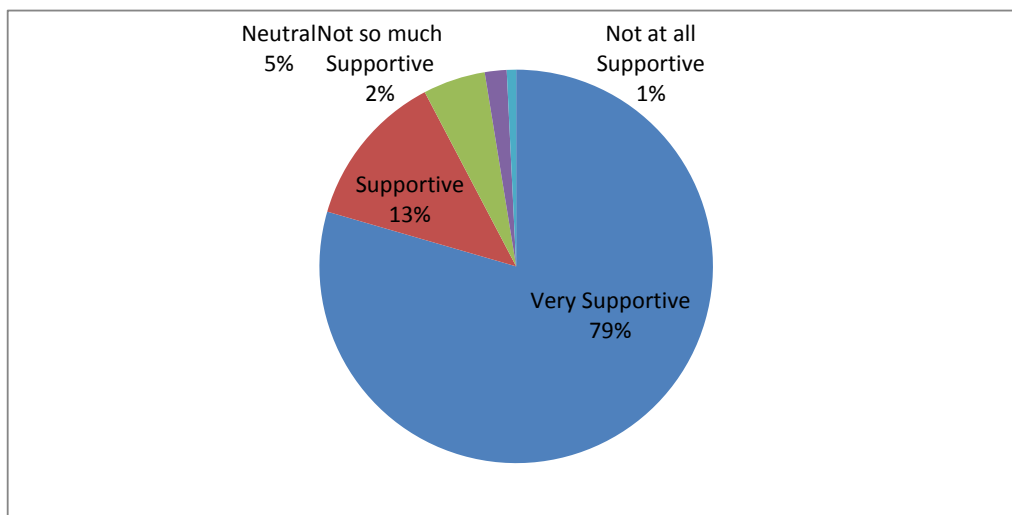
Q.11 Were assessments (e.g., exams, essays, presentations) fair and reflective of the course content?

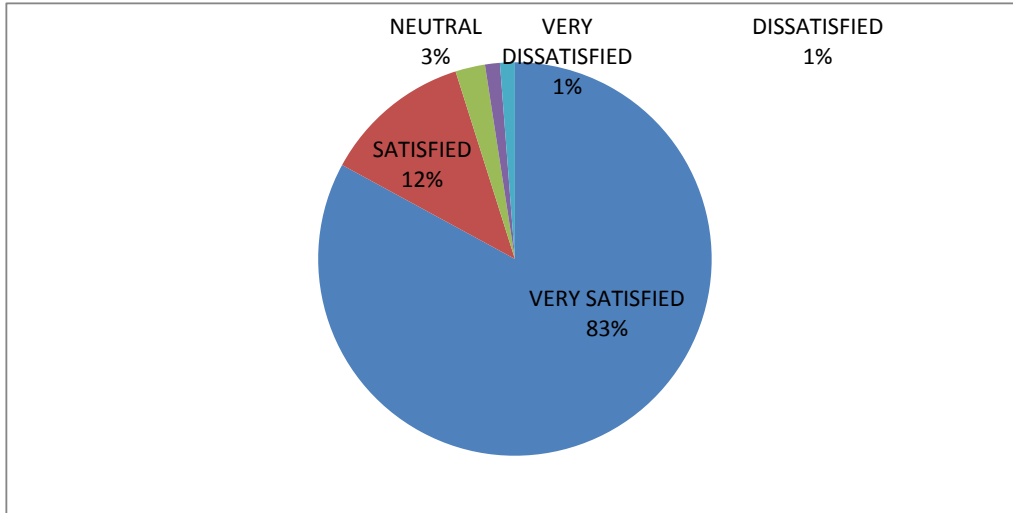
Q.12 How supportive and accessible were the professors for this course?

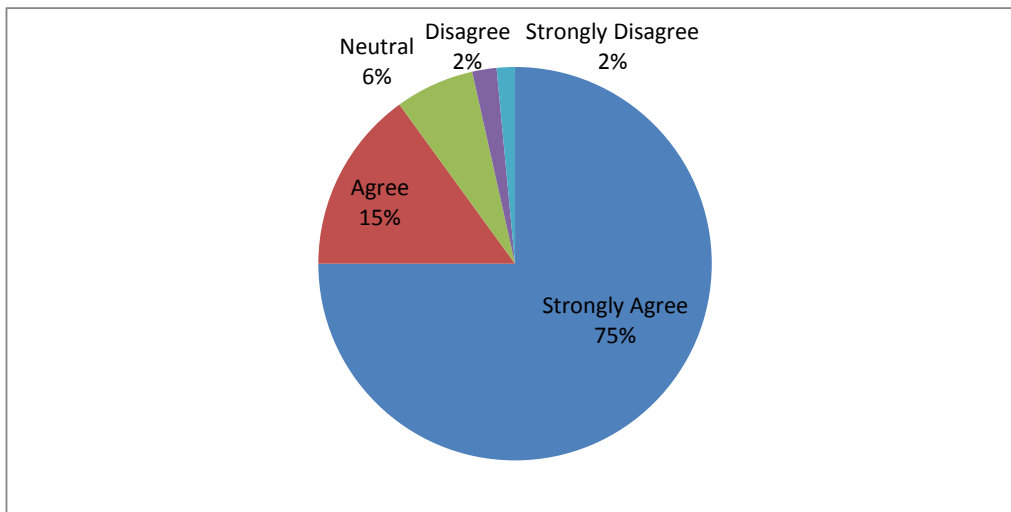
Q.13 How satisfied are you with the practical knowledge gained from this course?

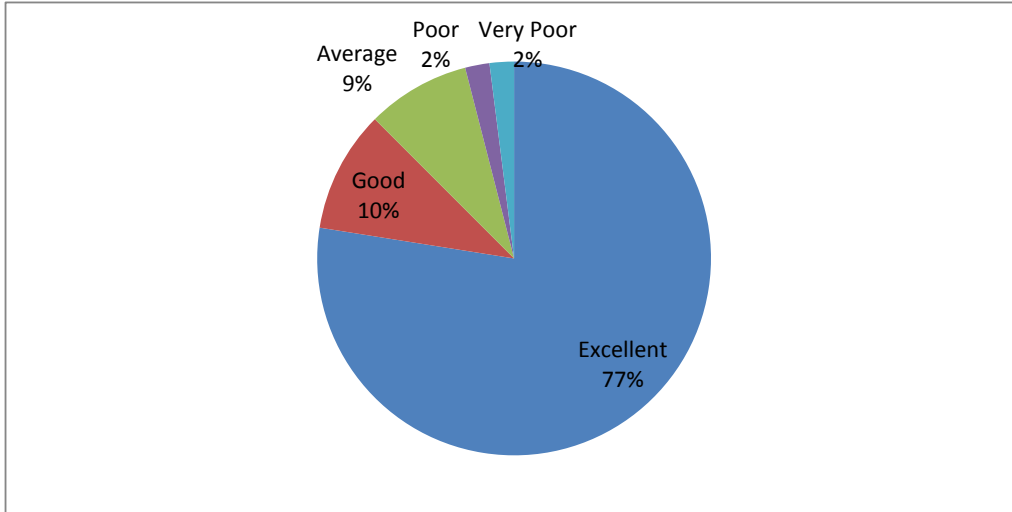
Q.14 Do you feel the course adequately prepared you for real-world applications in your field of study?

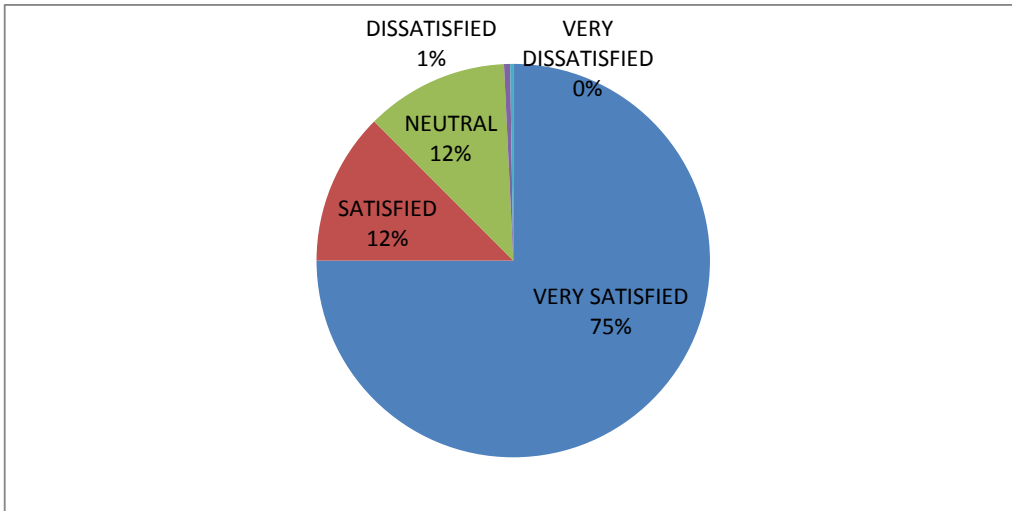
Q.15 Rate the effectiveness of practical components (e.g., labs, projects, internships) in enhancing your understanding of the subject matter.

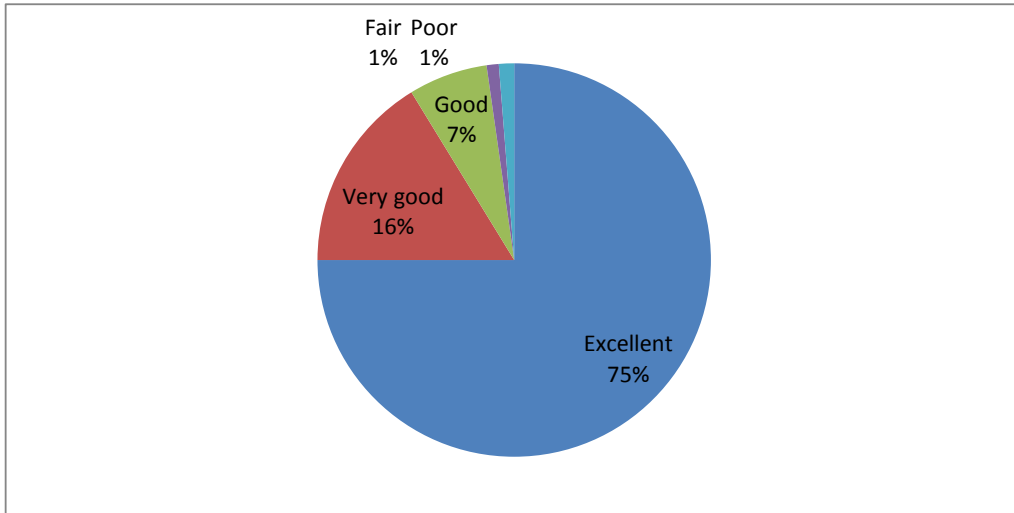
Q.16 How satisfied are you with the course's focus on developing job-related skills (e.g., communication, problem-solving, teamwork)?

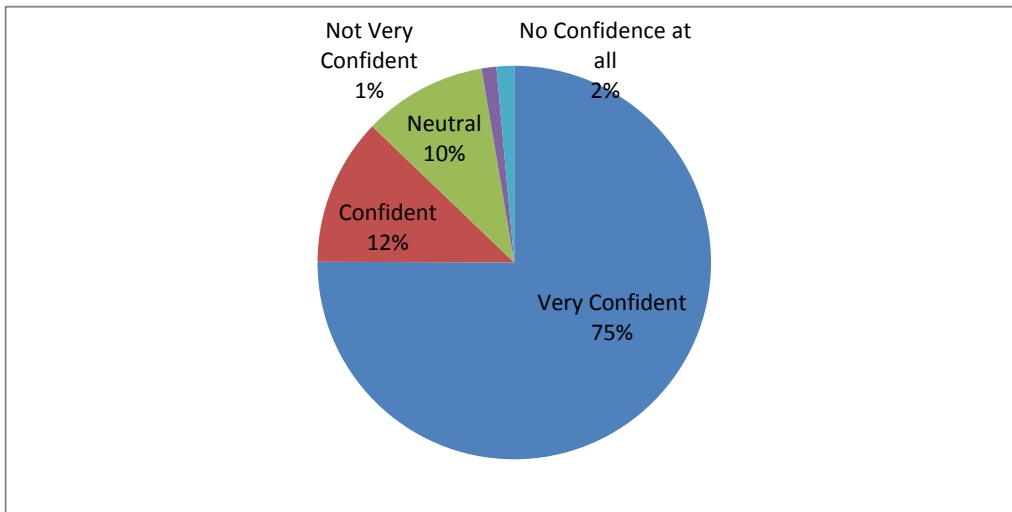
Q.17 Rate the effectiveness of career guidance and job placement services offered by the course/college.

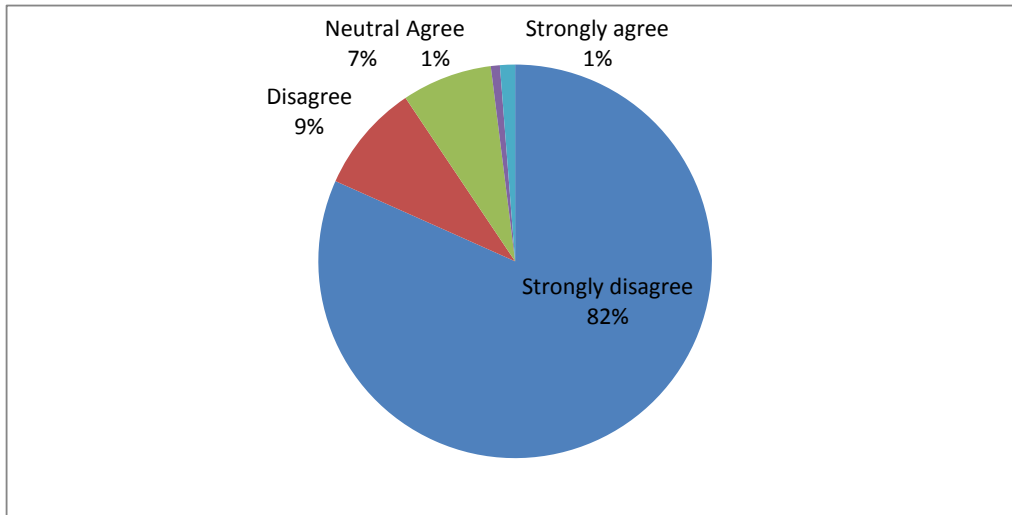
Q.18 How confident do you feel about your prospects for securing employment or further education after completing this course?*

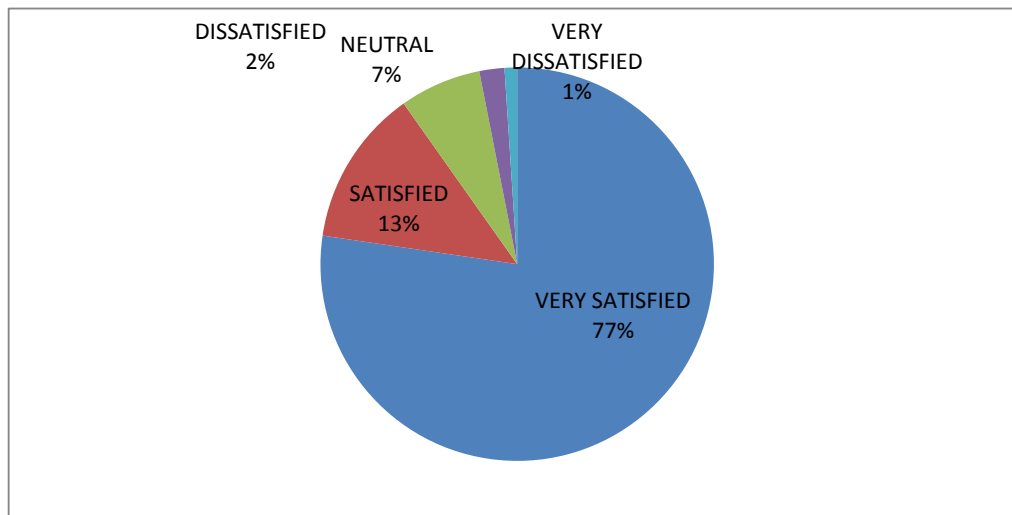
Q.19 Do you believe the course adequately addressed the current demands and trends in the job market for your field of study?

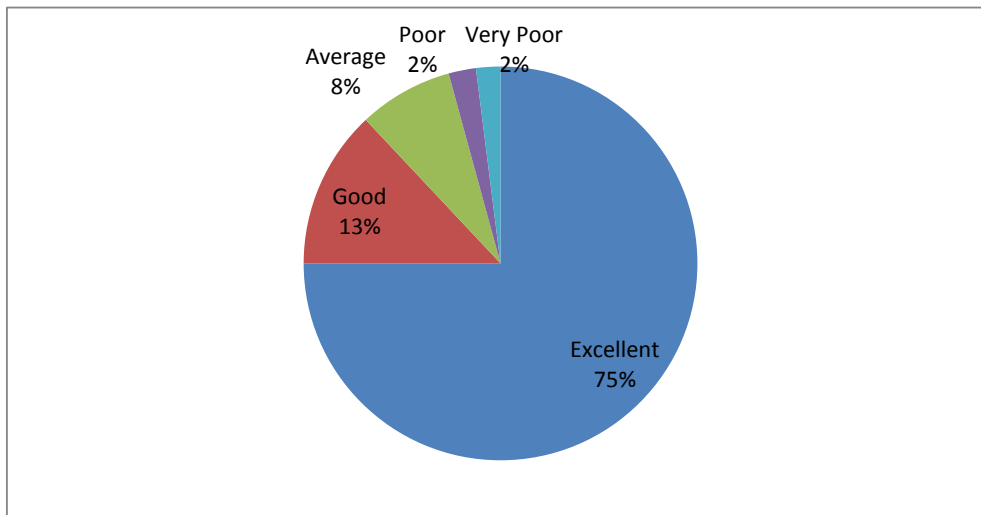
Q.20 How satisfied are you with the quality of teaching ?

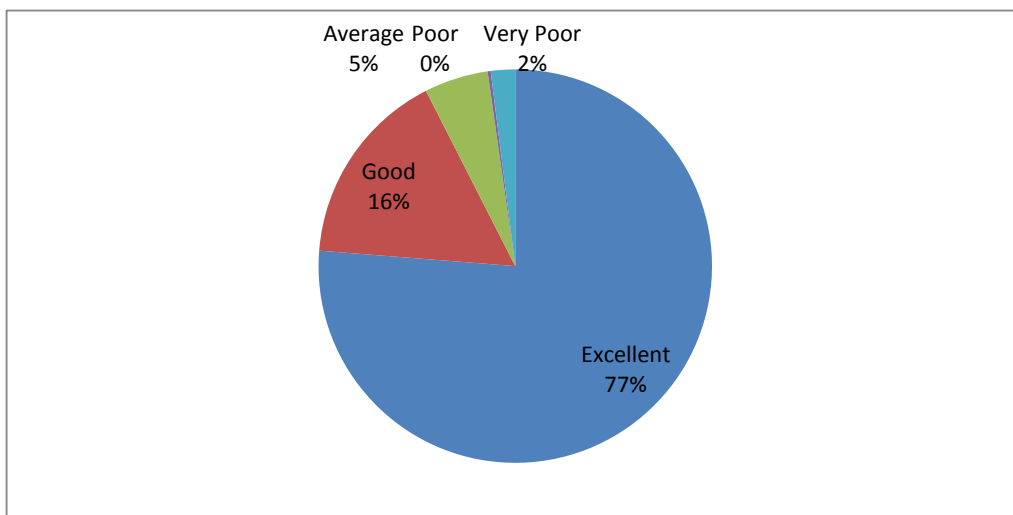
Q.21 Rate the availability of academic resources in the College(e.g., library, research materials).

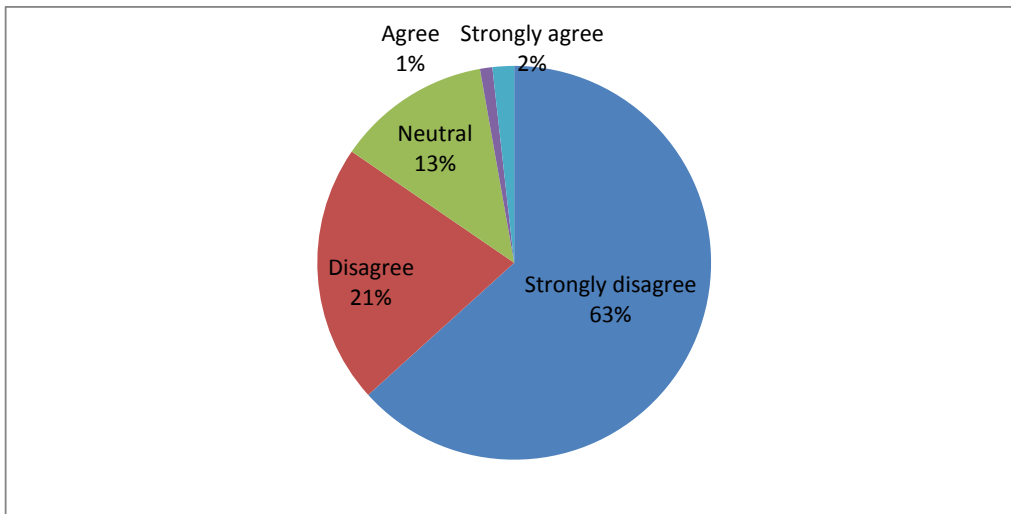
Q.22 How would you rate the variety and relevance of courses offered by the College?

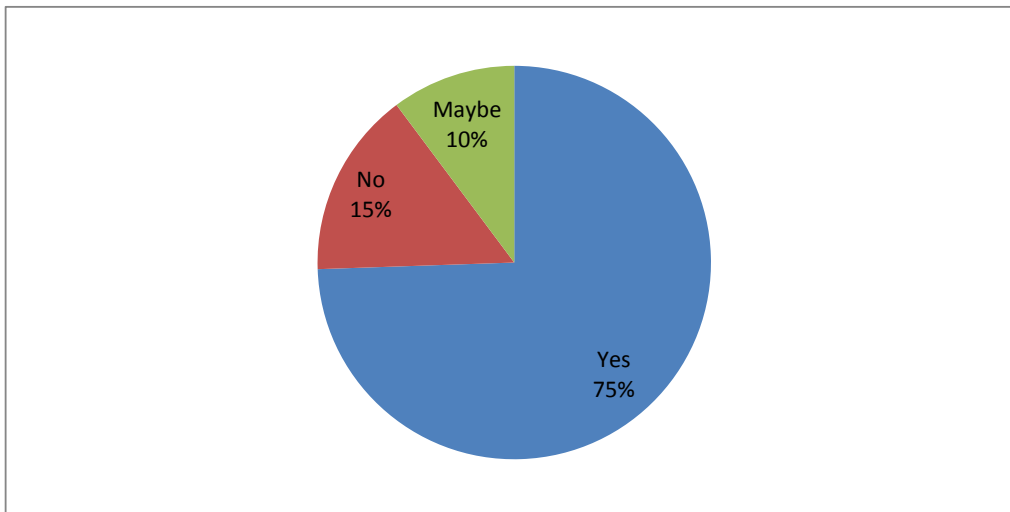
Q.23 Were extracurricular opportunities related to your course (e.g., field trips, conferences, research projects) adequately provided?*

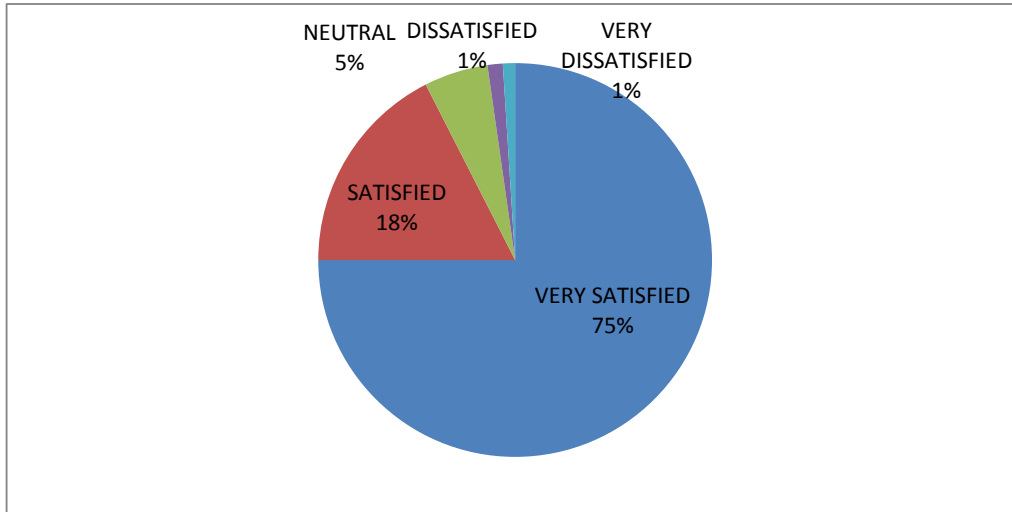
Q.24 Would you recommend your undergraduate program to prospective students?

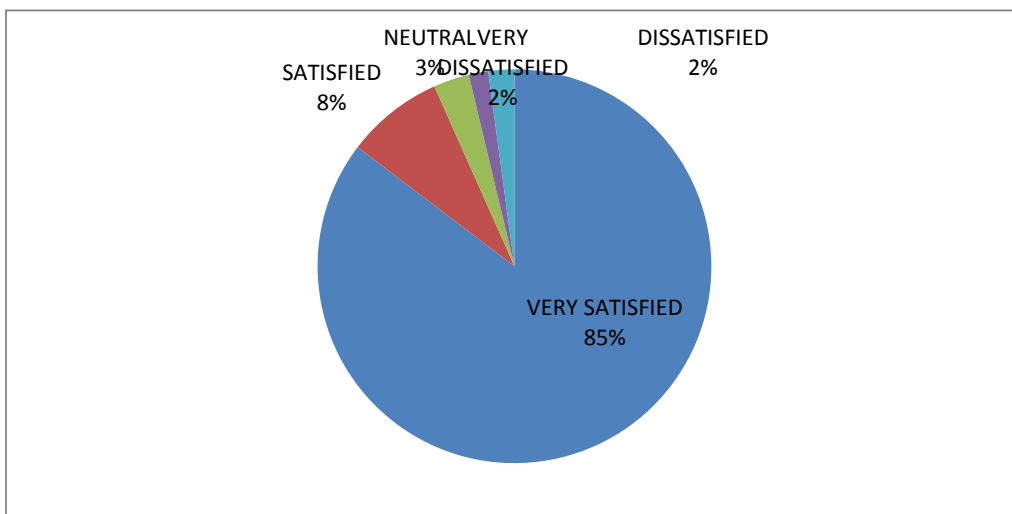
Q.25 How satisfied are you with the responsiveness of the non-teaching staff to your inquiries and requests?

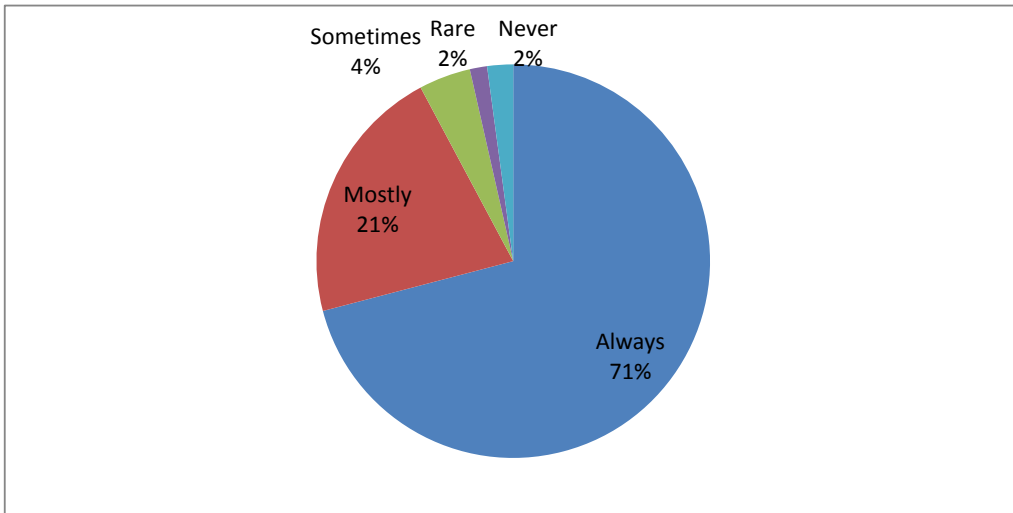
Q.26 How satisfied are you with the responsiveness of the non-teaching staff to your inquiries and requests?

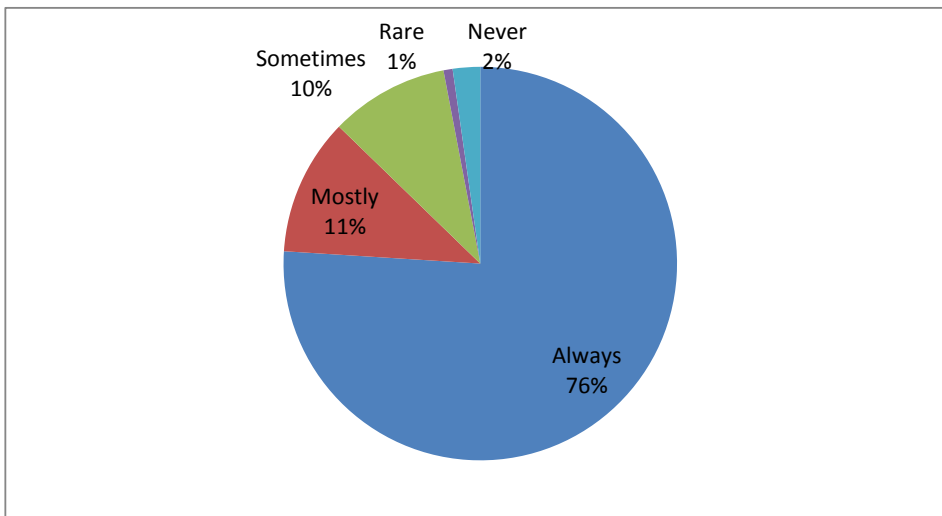
Q.27 Were you provided with accurate and timely information by the non-teaching staff when seeking assistance or guidance?

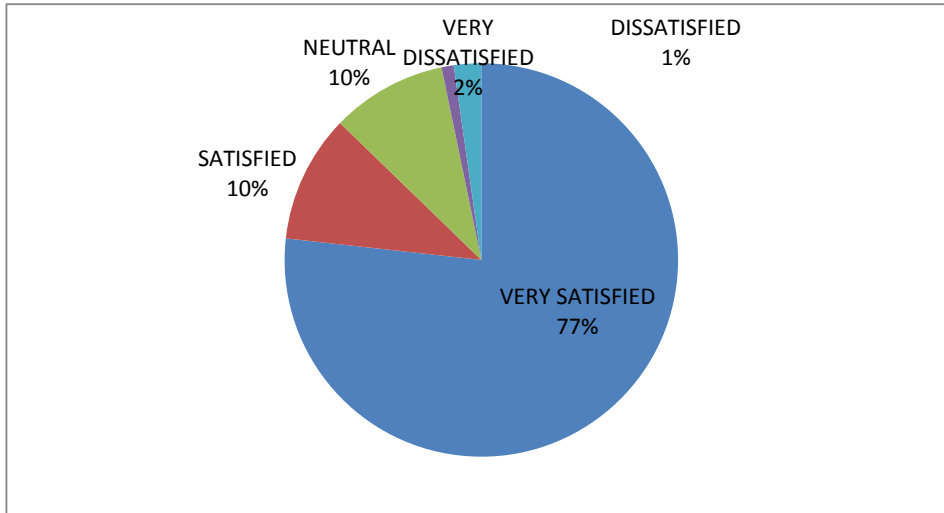
Q.28 Do you feel that the non-teaching staff in the college office respects student privacy and confidentiality?
